**Change of use of land for the siting of a mobile snack bar (Renewal of Temporary Permission Ref No 2009/0147/DET)
Loch Lubhair Lay-by, Crianlarich

I refer to your consultation received on 5 March 2014 regarding the above planning application and would offer the following comments.

The application site sits in a lay-by to the south of Loch Lubhair, adjacent to the A85 Perth-Oban Trunk Road.

The A85(T) forms part of the Trunk Road Network and Transport Scotland is responsible for issues pertaining to and affecting the Trunk Road Network. Transport Scotland Development Department – National Roads Directorate should therefore be consulted with regard to this application, in accordance with the requirements of Article 15 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development Procedures) Order 1992.

The management agent acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, responsible for the A85 Trunk Road is: Bear Scotland Ltd, Bear House, Inveralmond Road, Inveralmond Industrial Estate, Perth, PH1 3TW.

Therefore, taking the above into consideration I would indicate that this Service would have no objection to the proposal submitted, but ask that the management agent be consulted before any decision relating to planning consent is made.
