# **REQUEST UNDER ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2004**

I refer to your request for information, received by email on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

We have applied the exemption under Section 39(2) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 as we have determined that the information sought in your request is environmental information. We are therefore handling your request under the terms of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (EIRs). In this case the public interest in maintaining this exemption and in dealing with the request in line with the requirements of the EIRs outweighs any public interest in disclosing the information under FOISA.

Your specific request and the response from the National Park Authority are provided below.

## "Please could you clarify who authorised/confirmed this policy (Enforcement Policy) and what legal authority they had to do this."

The Your Park project board approved the Visitor Management Engagement and Enforcement Policy.

The Park Authority was created in accordance with the National Parks (Scotland) Act 2000. The Park Authority is responsible for all the functions of the Park Authority as set out in this legislation. and as such has the legal authority to develop, approve and implement policies to further the aims of the Act.

Consideration has been given to the public interest in the disclosure of this information. Release of this information is likely to have a negative impact on the ability of the Rangers to perform an effective role in working with the police, interacting with the public and, where required, submitting byelaw contravention reports.

It has been concluded that there is a greater public interest in Park Authority Rangers having an effective working relationship with Police Scotland which enables them to perform their duties in relation to the application of the camping management byelaws.

The Fixed Penalty notice documents submitted to the Park Authority Board at the meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> June 2016 have not been changed.
