This site is located in the heart of the Callander Conservation Area and while there are a number of non-traditional buildings on the site, none are as visually obtrusive and incongruous as the double height portacabins. They dwarf the nearby row of traditional cottages which are important features within the conservation area. Permission was granted previously for further single storey development on the site. This has not taken place so surely there would be the option to reconsider the development of the site to incorporate the necessary facilities provided currently by the portacabins. If this cannot be achieved, perhaps serious consideration should be given to the relocation of the business elsewhere in the town.

I am of the view that this application should be refused.
