Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002. received by email on 13th March 2015. Your specific requests and the responses from the National Park Authority are provided below.

1) Please provide me with the responses of Police Scotland, SEPA, Forestry Commission Scotland and Transport Scotland to the Your Park consultation. I already have copies of the responses from Sportscotland and SNH but would ask that in responding to this request you make those responses available on your website.

2) Please provide me with the responses of Stirling, Argyll and Bute, West Dunbartonshire and Perth and Kinross Councils to the Your Park consultation.

The Park Authority is currently examining all responses received in relation to the Your Park consultation. When this work is complete, the consultation responses will be published due to the considerable public interest in this project. This means that we are not obliged to release this information to you as it is scheduled for future publication under S27 (1)(a)(i) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

3) Please provide me with copies of all press releases the Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park (or any other body delegated to act on your behalf) has issued about the Your Park consultation.

- Submit your review request within 40 working days of either the date on which you received a response from the Authority or the date by which you should have received a response under the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, whichever is the later.
