## **REQUEST UNDER ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2004**

Thank you for your request for information, received by email on 4<sup>th</sup> February 2016 under the Environmental (Scotland) Regulations 2004. Your specific requests and the response from the National Park Authority are provided below.

I would suggest that SUSTRANS cannot have visited this site prior to works commencing, and that they have been very badly advised in that case by LLTNP regarding this being the way forward in relation to the upkeep of this pathway.

The issues that you have raised with us regarding the use of tarmac on Sustrans cycle track route 7 have been investigated under our formal complaints procedure, and a separate letter of response has been sent to you to explain in detail the reasons for the use of tarmac on this route.

I would like to know the names please of the persons and departments who recommended this action

The department that was involved in this project was the Visitor Experience team. The Recreation & Access Adviser, and the Estates Management Officer recommended the upgrade to this route. The use of sealed surfacing on paths is the recommended and most commonly used surface on national cycle network routes across Scotland.

## Who approved the action

The Park Authority Estates Manager approved this work.

# Whether they came to visit the site prior to approving the action

The Estates Manager did not visit the site prior to approving the work, however Park Authority Officers and Rangers frequently visit this site.

#### The estimated costs for this work

The Park Authority was advised that the estimated cost of the work, to be delivered by Stirling Council with funding provided by Sustrans would be approximately £89,000.
