Application made by Drummond Estates per James Denholm Partnership, 11 Dunira Street, Comrie, PH6 2LJ and received by Transport Scotland on 22 June 2012 for planning permission for change of use of land including an existing camping and caravan club site (5no. stances) to form a caravan park comprising 10no. stances, access road and parking located at Drummond Fish Farm, Lochearnhead affecting the A85 Trunk Road.

Director, Trunk Roads Network Management Advice

The Operating Company have responsibility for co-ordination and supervision of works and after permission has been granted it is the developer's contractor's responsibility to liaise with the Operating Company during the construction period to ensure all necessary permissions are obtained.

Trunk road modification works shall, in all respects, comply with the Design Manual for Roads and Bridges and the Specification for Highway Works published by HMSO. The developer shall issue a certificate to that effect, signed by the design organisation.

Trunk road modifications shall, in all respects, be designed and constructed to arrangements that comply with the Disability Discrimination Act: Good Practice Guide for Roads published by Transport Scotland. The developer shall provide written confirmation of this, signed by the design organisation.

**DETAILS of works necessary within the trunk road boundary:-**

Provision of visibility splays.

**CONDITIONS to be attached to any permission the council may give:-**

1	<p>If visibility splays can be provided and maintained on each side of the new access to the satisfaction of the local Planning Authority, Transport Scotland would have no objection to these proposals. These splays are the triangles of ground bounded on 2 sides by the first 4.5 metres of the centreline of the access driveway (the set back dimension) and the nearside trunk road carriageway measured 215 metres (the y dimension) in both directions from the intersection of the access with the trunk road. In a vertical plane, nothing shall obscure visibility measured from a driver's eye height of between 1.05 metres and 2.00 metres positioned at the set back dimension to an object height of between 0.26 metres and 1.05 metres anywhere along the y dimension.</p>
