## Q." all information the LLTNPA holds (papers, internal communications, external correspondence) on the LLTNPA's intention to prosecute people camping in contravention of the proposed camping byelaws but abiding by Scottish Outdoor Access Code."

A.Under R10(4)(c) of the EIRs, we have to advise that it has not been possible to identify relevant information to answer this request, as it is formulated in too general a manner.

In order to comply with our duty to advise and assist under R9 of the EIRs, we can advise that the Scottish Outdoor Access Code is a practical guide to access rights and responsibilities while the Camping Management Byelaws are legally enforceable laws which will come into force from the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017, as directed by Scottish Ministers.

While the Park Authority hopes that there will be no requirement to prosecute anyone, the Camping Management Byelaws are legally enforceable laws and it may be necessary for the Park Authority to take enforcement action as a last resort where there has been a contravention of the byelaws.

## Q. "I am also requesting under FOI who authorised the Questions and Answer piece which has been published on the Your Park blog under the name Magic Dust."

A.'Magic Dust' is a username for a member of staff logging on to the website to add in updates. Updates to the website are authorised by the Head of Communications.

## Q."I also request copies of all written materials, including presentations, that were provided to participants in the stakeholder meeting to discuss the Park's camping strategy under FOI legislation."
