- 1. <u>Purpose</u>
  - 1.1 To present the draft Annual Operational Plan for 2018/19 for approval.
- 2. <u>Recommendation</u>

## 3. Background

- 3.1 This Draft Annual Operational Plan has been produced in a similar format to 2016/17 and 2017/18, which has been well-received by Board members.
- 3.2 The Plan has taken into account appropriate changes to the Scottish Government's Programme for Scotland and alignment with and delivery of the Board approved 2018-2023 National Park Partnership Plan.
- 3.3 It is the intention, starting from 2018/19, that reporting progress towards the Annual Operational Plan will be made to the Park Authority Board.
- 3.4 The plan features 2018 Year of Young People as well as focusing on 5 priority areas; Conservations, Visitor Experience, Visitor Operations, Rural Development and our Regulatory/Statutory/Good Governance responsibilities.
- 3.5 The Plan has been produced alongside the preparation of the 2018/19 Draft Budget.

## 4. <u>Conclusion</u>

- 4.1 There are 18 targeted "activities" and corresponding "measurement(s) of success".
- 4.2 There continues to be a good balance of objectives which aim to address all four National Park aims.
