### **REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002**

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, received by email on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2016. Your specific requests and the response by the Park Authority are provided below.

**“I would like to request a list of people who have gone missing within the Loch Lomond and The Trossachs National Park between January 2004 and January 2014.**

**I would like the dates of the disappearances and whether or not the missing persons were found. If the missing persons were found, were they alive or deceased?”**

Although the Park Authority and its staff would assist where requested in the case of a person missing within the National Park, the Authority does not keep a record of the cases.

Accordingly, I have to advise you under section 17(1)(b) of the Act, that the Authority does not hold the information you have requested.

## Review Procedure
