







# Percentage of Ranger visits where they did/did not encounter litter within a Camping Management Zone




## Appendix 4(b): Percentage of Ranger visits where a litter type was observed (2018 versus 2019)







Appendix 6: Average number of fires observed per site by Rangers (2011 – 2019)




Appendix 7: Total number of permits sold (tent permits and motorhome permits) 2017 - 2019




Appendix 8: Age range of visitors to the National Park according to Visitor Surveys in 2015 and 2019




Appendix 9: Permit area bookings by home location in Scotland 2017-2019

Appendix 11: Annual total number of adults and children camping in permit areas 2017 - 2019




