Applying for a review

We have 2 months from receipt of a valid application to decide whether it should be approved or refused. If by 9 January 2021 we have not made a decision or you have not agreed in writing to extend the decision-making time period, you may wish to apply for a review on non-determination to the **Loch Lomond & Trossachs Local Review Body**. Your application for review must be made within **three months** of the date when your application should have been decided. Requests for review must be made on the Notice of Review form which is available to download on the e-planning portal https://www.eplanning.scot/ePlanningClient/default.aspx. Alternatively, please phone the Local Review Clerk at the National Park Authority on 01389 722017 or e-mail planning.reviews@lochlomond-trossachs.org if you would like a form sent out. You can also write to us using the address below. Following submission of the Notice of Review Form, you will receive an acknowledgement letter informing you of the Local Review Body date or whether further information is required.

Description of Proposal

If the description of your proposal differs slightly from that submitted, this alteration has been necessary to make it more explicit and legally correct. This revised description will appear on the Decision Notice and it is assumed that the above is acceptable to you unless you indicate otherwise.

Building Warrant
