REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

We refer to your requests for information, received in three emails on 31st January 2023. The information you have requested is environmental information, as defined in Regulation 2 of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (EIRs). We have therefore applied the exemption in section 39(2) of FOISA and dealt with your request under the EIRs alone.

Your specific requests and the Park Authority's response are provided below.

'Please provide me with copies of all the responses to the Loch Lomond byelaw review that were made by organisations (as opposed to individuals). In my view, the LLTNPA Publication Scheme should make publication of such responses routine, as happens with responses to Scottish Government consultations.'

The pdf search functionality in the document can be used to identify the responses to the Loch Lomond byelaw review that were made by organisations. We can therefore advise under R6(1)(b) of the EIRs that this information is already publicly available and easily accessible.

'Please provide me with the number of breaches under the Loch Lomond byelaws referred to the Procurator Fiscal between 2012 and 2022 broken down by the type of craft and offence.'

Details of breaches of the Loch Lomond byelaws reported to the Procurator Fiscal by the National Park Authority between 2012 and 2022 are provided in the table below. There were no breaches reported to the Fiscal in 2017 and 2020. Accordingly, we have to advise under Regulation 10(4)(a) of the EIRs that this information is not held.

There was one case reported to the Fiscal in 2012, under the Loch Lomond Byelaws 2006, for the offence under section 3.5(6(a) Lifejackets –

"The master of a boat (other than a personal water craft including a jet ski or jet bike) shall ensure that at all times the boat is carrying sufficient lifejackets or buoyancy aids of the standard specified in sub section (d) of an appropriate size and weight for each person on board at any one time"

'Please provide me with the number of jet skis (PWCs) registered under the Loch Lomond byelaws for each year from 2012-2022 broken down by those owned by businesses and those owned by individuals.'

The National Park Authority issued figures for the number of PWCs registered under the Loch Lomond byelaws for every year from 2012 to 2021 in response to a request for this information in 2022. We can therefore advise under R6(1)(b) of the EIRs that this information is already publicly available and easily accessible.

As you have requested the number of PWCs registered in 2022 in your request dated 30th January 2023, we are not required to provide this information again as it has already been provided and this is a repeat request for the same information.

All vessels registered with the National Park Authority under the Loch Lomond byelaws are registered by an individual owner of the vessel, we do not record information about businesses on the boat registration database. We therefore have to advise under Regulation 10(4)(a) of the EIRs that this information is not held.
