REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

We refer to your request for information, received by email on 11th September 2023. Your specific requests and the National Park Authority's response are provided below.

'1) Please provide information about any grants awarded to DCDT Enterprise Company Limited in relation to a Green Cycle Hub in Drymen.

The National Park Authority launched a £250,000 Green Recovery Fund in 2021/22 to help local communities and businesses recover from the pandemic in a sustainable way.

The National Park Authority awarded funding from the Green Recovery Fund to DCDP Enterprise, to support a project for the provision of charging points for e-bike batteries and a tool station for bike maintenance within the Drymen Village Square bus shelter, adding to the Green Cycle Hub that DCDT Enterprise are developing, to improve infrastructure and accessibility for walkers and cyclists.
