REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

We refer to your request for information, received by email on 22nd December 2023. Your specific requests and the Park Authority's response are provided below.

“Please provide me with copies of all orders made by the Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park as access authority under Section 11 of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 or, if it is more convenient, the dates covered of such all orders, the area of land affected and the reason for the order.”

Since 2005 the National Park Authority has received 140 applications to restrict access for the purpose of various events across Loch Lomond & The Trossachs National Park.

Due to data retention schedules, full details of applicants are not retained for more than 2 years after the event has been taken place, however reference, purpose and dates are retained. The table below is based on applications received, some of which were rejected (application not required or not received in time) or events cancelled or rescheduled.

NB Events can be held without application for exemption; however, organisers cannot restrict non-motorised access and are subject to being challenged by attendees. To date there have been no complaints to LLTNPA of any incidences of this occurring.
