Information Notice: proposed Kilmaronock Local Place Plan for comment

Dear Councillors,

I am contacting you on behalf of **Kilmaronock Community Council** and **Kilmaronock Community Trust**. We have been working on a Local Place Plan for our Community Council area, involving community engagement over the last few months.

We have now prepared a draft Local Place Plan. It has just been published online for public consultation at <https://kilmaronockcc.org/kilmaronock-local-place-plan> and <https://gartocharn.org/KLPP> until **Friday 26 January 2024**. 2. Brief description of the content and purpose of the proposed Local Place Plan

The Plan covers the Kilmaronock Community Council area, which stretches north to south from Inchmurrin Island to Auchenreoch Muir and west to east from Balloch to Drymen & Croftamie. A map of the Community Council area can be seen near the start of the Plan.

The primary purpose of the Plan is to provide an up-to-date statement of current issues we face and our aspirations for the next 10 years, to help public bodies, landowners, businesses and funders consider how they can best support positive change in the area.

There are 6 priority themes for action :

- A Safe and Accessible Place
- A Linked Up Place
- A Climate Friendly Place with a Sustainable Environment
- A Place with a Campus of Excellent Facilities
- A Family Centred Place
- A Living and Vibrant Place
