Selection criteria

Applications will be scored against four criteria:

- 1. An interest in/experience of exercising access rights/enjoying outdoor activities and/or managing land used for access, or an interest in public access from another perspective.
- 2. A specific area of interest in one or more of the specified areas.
- 3. A broad understanding of access rights/responsibilities/SOAC
- 4. A broad awareness of the role of the National Park Authority

We will use a 0 - 3 marking system:

- 0 no evidence/poor response/indicates no, or very little, understanding
- 1 fair: referred to but not expanded upon/indicates some understanding
- 2 good: referenced and some evidence/indicates good understanding
- 3 excellent: clearly grasped and evidenced/indicates excellent understanding

Applicants must score 1 or more in all categories listed above, except understanding of the legislation/SOAC (category 3). Those scoring 2 and above in relation to 'specific areas of interest' (category 2, i.e. those considered suitable to fill representation 'gaps' in current Forum membership) will be positively weighted.

Scores will be totalled and the applicants ranked.
