## **REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002**

Thank you for your request for access to information held by the National Park Authority, which we received by email on 29 August 2024. We have determined that the information you have requested is environmental information, as set out in the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (EIRs). Under section 39(2) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA), environmental information is exempt from disclosure under FOISA, as it is covered by the EIRs. As a result, we are processing your request under the EIRs.

### **Your Request**

"Re-reading the response [EIR-2016-051], however, I note that "In addition some email correspondence which includes details of the developer bids has been withheld from release as this information is commercially sensitive and excepted from release under R10(5)(e) and R10(5)(f) of the EIRs". The purpose of this email is to make a new request for that information which was withheld noting that the applicability of the exemptions you have quoted are likely to have changed in the intervening period."

#### Our Response

We have reviewed the material that was collated in relation to EIR-2016-051 and confirm that, where information was withheld for reasons other than the protection of personal data, the exemptions that applied in 2016, do not apply today. Please find attached the information that was previously withheld from disclosure. Please note that personal data continues to be redacted, in line with Regulation 10(3) and Regulation 11 of the EIRs.

The review will be handled by staff who were not involved in the original decision. You will receive notice of the result of your review within 20 working days.


