REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

We refer to your request for information, received by email on 10 April 2025. The information you have requested is environmental information, as defined in Regulation 2 of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (EIRs). We have therefore applied the exemption in section 39(2) of FOISA and dealt with your request under the EIRs alone.

Your Request

Please can you tell me

1. Whether you collect data on fires that occur in listed buildings in your planning area
2. Whether you keep record of derelict buildings in your planning area, including any records on risks associated with their condition
3. If yes, please share
 - a) Any records that you have of fires that have occurred in listed buildings in your planning area from 1st January 2018 to 31st December 2024 (inclusive) in a .csv or .xlsx file
 - b) Any records that you have of derelict buildings in your planning area from 1st January 2018 to 31st December 2024 (inclusive) in a .csv or .xlsx file
 - c) The name, date, and location of fires in derelict listed buildings in your area from 1st January 2018 to 31st December 2024 (inclusive) in a .csv or .xlsx file

Our Response

1. We do not record data on fires in listed buildings within the National Park. Therefore, we advise you under Regulation 10(4)(a) of the EIRs, that the information you have requested is not held by the National Park Authority.
2. The records of listed derelict buildings within the National Park are contained within the Register found here: <https://www.buildingsatrisk.org.uk/>, which is maintained by Historic Environment Scotland (HES). The last resurvey of the National Park, to inform and update the Register, was undertaken by HES in 2022.
