Thank you for your request for access to information held by the National Park Authority, which we received by email on the 09 June 2025. We have processed your request under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 and have provided our response below.

Your Request

- 3. The total number of staff responsible for awarding grants in the previous 3 financial years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25).
- 4. A list of all projects awarded grants by the authority with a total value of the grant for each project in the previous 3 financial years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25)."
