





So as I now understand it, there has been no overall proposed reduction in the number of apartments (15+6) (it was just that the original planning statement was incorrect)? Please confirm that the only reduction proposed from the original accommodation quantum is the 17 bothies and the 5 no. lodges?

#### Other points/corrections

- EIAR Vol 2 Appendix 6.6 Retained and Replacement Woodland document is not displaying properly, and the plan is broken over several sheets. Please provide replacement e copy of this plan on one sheet.
- 2. Page 8 of the updated planning statement omits reference to the 15 proposed apartments at Woodbank House. Please add this in to ensure that the statement correctly captures all 21 apartments proposed.
- 3. Zone D(11) re the buffer. The Cover letter refers to Area 10 being removed so no need for a buffer, however this question concerned the proposed buffer in zone D(11) behind to the east of properties on Drunkinnon Gate. The parameters plan key states 12m buffer from the dwellings however the buffer strip as indicatively drawn does not look to be 12m wide (more like half that) so is the buffer measured from the dwelling facades or the rear garden boundary? Clarity about where this measurement is taken from should be indicated on the parameters plan for the avoidance of doubt.
- 4. Where can I find a summary of the assessment of the loss and gain / net gain woodland figures? Given this was a key matter raised in high profile objections it would be helpful if the updated woodland loss/gain figures were highlighted somewhere in the table in the covering letter. I see there is a summary in the response to the National Trust representation is this somewhere in the EIA submission itself? Apologies if I have missed it.
- 5. Where can I find your 'workings out' for the parking figures? It would be helpful to know how the figures were calculated given objector scrutiny. Again, I've not been able to locate this, apologies if I have missed it.

I may have further queries as I work through.

Thank you for inviting further comment on the above application. Many of the queries are for LLTNP to answer, however we have provided comments on some of the points raised in Stantec's letter of 11 April 2024. We are, and remain, amenable to further meetings regarding this site, however it appears that in this letter that none of the technical points in relation to updated flood modelling raised in our letter of 5 April 2024 have been addressed, we need at least some response to our technical points before we attend a further meeting. We note that the applicant considers this to be a matter for the detailed design stage. SEPA would welcome LLTNP's views on this matter before considering this further. To clarify the 'in principle' query below, we do not object to the principle of the site being developed, on the provision that LLTNP classify the site as an exception under Policy 22a, however SEPA consider that further technical detail is needed at this stage to ascertain what development may be able to take place.

All points below are in relation to Stantec's letter of 11 April 2024 unless stated otherwise. Titles from that letter are bolded and italicised below for ease of refence.

# Paragraph 4: SEPAs approach to the application of Parts i – iv is to rely on the advice of the Planning Authority as decision-maker. The Planning Authority have not confirmed their view that Part iv applies.

With regards to the statement that 'no stilts or pillars are proposed' on the 'Flood Extents and Mitigation Plan' (available on the planning portal), cross section A-A shows a chalet on stilts. This is where SEPA formed this view from. The same plan is provided at the end of this letter, which shows a stilted chalet. If the chalets are not to be stilted we would expect plans be changed to reflect this.

# In any event, it is also noted that SEPA's Position Statement: Elevated buildings in areas of flood risk (September 2023) does not preclude the use stilts or pillars if NPF4 Policy 22 is complied with.

To clarify, this is on the proviso that all criteria are met which is made up of both those criteria stated in Policy 22 Exception 4 and those in SEPA Elevated Structures guidance.

Criteria 3 of SEPA guidance states – 'Proposals must not create an island of development (i.e., development must adjoin developed areas outwith the flood risk area)'.

This proposal involves buildings adjoining 'made-up/ raised ground' within the flood risk area, rather than buildings being connected to land out with the flood risk area.

The glossary of our Elevated Structures guidance goes on to define an island of development as: Buildings located above the design flood level but surrounded by lower ground at flood risk on all sides not directly connected to areas outwith the flood risk area. To avoid doubt, the inclusion of a raised walkway does not stop a layout being considered an island of development.

What is proposed here are new 'raised earth' walkways within the flood risk area rather than raised walkways constructed of wood or metal. However, they may still be considered as creating an island of development for every chalet proposed.

# Paragraph 1.2 advises that in accordance with NPF4 Policy 22a, sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings must be identified through the development planning process.

It is our position that certain flood risk mitigation can only be acceptable when they come through a local plan, for example Landraising and Comp' Storage under SPP7/SPP. Similarly, in Version 1 (Jan 2022) of our SEPA Elevated Structures guidance we stated:

Sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings are best identified through the development planning process, where the need to manage flood risk rather than avoid it can be considered alongside and balanced with other policy and placemaking considerations.

In our latest version of the Elevated Structures guidance (Sept 2023), we reiterate the above, yet emphasizing what is said in Policy 22 of NPF4, as below:

In accordance with Policy 22, sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings must be identified through the development planning process, where the need to manage flood risk rather than avoid it can be considered alongside and balanced with other policy and placemaking considerations.

## Paragraphs 1.8 and 1.9 refer to the proposed paths may need to be raised 600mm higher than the current suggestion of 200 year + climate change flood level (10.65 AOD)

If 600mm can be added to the raised paths without widening the base of the paths then that is noted. We agree that more detailed modelling would have to be undertaken at the detailed design stage should PPiP be granted.

Paragraphs 1.10 and 1.11 refers to more modelling being required without the existing informal defences (riverside embankment) being in place.

SEPA agree that box culverts may be better than pipes - however, this is indeed matters for a detailed stage if (and only if) PPiP can be granted by LLTNP I trust the above is of use. Please let me know if you have any further gueries. 



Buildings located above the design flood level but surrounded by lower ground at flood risk on all sides not directly connected to areas outwith the flood risk area. To avoid doubt, the inclusion of a raised walkway does not stop a layout being considered an island of development.

What is proposed here are new 'raised earth' walkways within the flood risk area rather than raised walkways constructed of wood or metal. However, they may still be considered as creating an island of development for every chalet proposed.

## Paragraph 1.2 advises that in accordance with NPF4 Policy 22a, sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings must be identified through the development planning process.

It is our position that certain flood risk mitigation can only be acceptable when they come through a local plan, for example Landraising and Comp' Storage under SPP7/SPP. Similarly, in Version 1 (Jan 2022) of our SEPA Elevated Structures guidance we stated:

Sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings are best identified through the development planning process, where the need to manage flood risk rather than avoid it can be considered alongside and balanced with other policy and placemaking considerations.

In our latest version of the Elevated Structures guidance (Sept 2023), we reiterate the above, yet emphasizing what is said in Policy 22 of NPF4, as below:

In accordance with Policy 22, sites suitable for the development of elevated buildings must be identified through the development planning process, where the need to manage flood risk rather than avoid it can be considered alongside and balanced with other policy and placemaking considerations.

### Paragraphs 1.8 and 1.9 refer to the proposed paths may need to be raised 600mm higher than the current suggestion of 200 year + climate change flood level (10.65 AOD)

If 600mm can be added to the raised paths without widening the base of the paths then that is noted. We agree that more detailed modelling would have to be undertaken at the detailed design stage should PPiP be granted.

### Paragraphs 1.10 and 1.11 refers to more modelling being required without the existing informal defences (riverside embankment) being in place.

SEPA agree that box culverts may be better than pipes - however, this is indeed matters for a detailed stage if (and only if) PPiP can be granted by LLTNP I trust the above is of use.

I note that the technical issues that SEPA have raised and their request for further information from you has been passed to the Applicant's hydrologist. As you will further note below it is important that we receive any further response to SEPA's letter - including from the Applicants hydrologist - as soon as possible.

I note you take issue with the Park Authority Planning Officers not at this stage being prepared to provide an opinion on the planning status of the Application site. Whether the NPF4 Policy 22 a) iv. exception applies involves a complex and important planning policy interpretation and assessment which requires examination and assessment of all the relevant evidence - including your

Information Note on this topic. The planning status of the Application site is not therefore "simply be a statement of fact" (as you state) and it involves the exercise of planning judgement on the facts. It is not accepted that you or SEPA in raising this issue places a requirement or duty on Park Authority Planning Officers to reach a conclusion on this complex matter at this stage. That policy exception (if it applies) also requires that proposals demonstrate that long term safety and resilience can be secured in accordance with SEPA's advice - that is why we have been seeking (over a considerable period of time) technical guidance from SEPA.

The Park Authority Planning Officers' assessment of the Application against NPF4 Policy 22 will be published in due course as part of the Planning Officers Report and Recommendation to the Park Authority Board.

As you are aware, a significant amount of additional environmental information concerning the EIAR and the Application has been submitted since last summer concerning roads and flood matters. We have held off publishing this for some considerable time whilst we sought to obtain clarity on these matters which has been reliant on information from the Applicant and advice from statutory consultees. The Park Authority are under a duty (under the EIA Regulations 2017) to publish, consult and renotify on this information and facilitate further representations to be made.

You may be aware that on 9 April this week we received the final consultation response from WDC Roads Authority. Considering we now have further consultation responses from both WDC and SEPA it is our intention to proceed with this regulatory requirement within the next two weeks. Once this exercise has been completed (including receipt of representations on that information) it is our intention to move relatively quickly to the preparation and publication our Officer's Report and Recommendation on the Application.





Thanks for your response. I can confirm none of the additional information submitted related to ground contamination or noise. It principally relates to traffic and flood risk.

FYI the application is PPiP so if approved we would anticipate development to come forward in phases through subsequent MSC applications for each development zone A-E.

Would it be possible for you to clarify whether you wish the noise conditions to be applied to all phases of the development including the self-catering accommodation proposals or just particular phases (for example those which contain commercial buildings (hotel/budget accommodation/brewery/restaurants etc and infrastructure (monorail)). Likewise I'm presuming that the ventilation/flue

condition would just be for the commercial uses and not the self-catering accommodation?

We are able to condition further pre-commencement works (for example site surveys) to any MSC approvals in due course. So discussions could be held at that stage as required.

- 1. I am presuming that your below response is an interim response pending receipt of the clarifications that you have sought from the applicant that will enable you to finalise your advice to us. Once you are in a position to finalise your consultation response, please send this to us under separate cover and we will publish it on the portal at the appropriate time. Please confirm whether the attached report is intended to be published alongside your final response or whether this is just for your internal use.
- 2. In your final response to us please include any planning conditions that you require to be attached to any permission the planning authority may issue. If the position of the Roads Authority is that mitigation in the form of road upgrades at the McDonalds roundabout are required in order to avoid an objection, then a condition securing these should be requested. If detailed drawings of the mitigation works are available then the condition should reference these and we will need these details/plans to publish alongside your final response. If the scheme has yet to be designed in detail then the condition should describe the extent of works required to be undertaken and require further detailed drawings to be submitted and when these must be implemented by (prior to commencement or occupation whichever timeframe the Roads Authority deems most appropriate).
- 3. You mention the upgrade works that have already been agreed with Transport Scotland in relation to the Stoneymollan Roundabout and that you have taken these into account in designing up the mitigation. Transport Scotland have not formally requested any such measures or conditions to secure these works in their response to the application. Implementation of the Section 48 agreement we understand is now in place between Transport Scotland and the applicant pertaining to these works would be at the behest of Transport Scotland and the planning authority cannot seek to enforce the works or influence their timing. It is not clear whether your advice is predicated on these works being undertaken. For the avoidance of doubt, please confirm that the traffic impacts would remain acceptable to the Roads Authority (subject to the mitigation above) in the absence of the Stoneymollan Roundabout works. If the impacts at McDonalds roundabout would be unacceptable without these works then the Road Authority will need to request that the planning authority use available means to secure them (i.e. suspensive planning condition or legal agreement).
- 4. In your previous responses (17 March 2023, 16 May 2023) various points were raised regarding other aspects of the submission including Parking and Signage strategy and Framework Travel Plan etc. In your final response to us please confirm that all those requirements have been addressed to your satisfaction. Please also reiterate any related conditions that the Road Authority requires to be attached to any planning permission the planning authority may be minded to grant.

In regards to the above planning application I would offer the following response from WDC Roads.

WDC Roads have had the modelling/traffic figures assessed by our consultant (report attached) and as you can see there is still a number of point outstanding which would allow us to validate the report submitted in support of the application.

For your convenience and ease of reference I have listed these points below;

Consultant to confirm the correct land uses have been used.

Consultant to provide the August 2023 traffic scenario

A comparison of observed/ modelled queues should be provided along with justification / commentary as to the appropriateness of the base model results.

Further information needs to be provided on modelling validation and justification provided that existing junction models reasonably reflect existing conditions/operation.

Whilst WDC still seek clarification from the applicants on the information highlighted in the report, however based on the information provided the proposed development will result in an increase in traffic flows in the AM, PM and Saturday peak and that the impact will result in a deterioration of the junction performance of the Stoneymollan Roundabout and Ballochloan (Old Luss Road) Roundabout.

Given the current figures result in a deterioration of junction performance at the Ballochloan (Old Luss Road) Roundabout, WDC Roads would require mitigation measures at this location to offset the increased traffic flow. We are aware that upgrade works have already been agreed with Transport Scotland in relation to the Stoneymollan Roundabout and therefore have not included for any additional measures at this location.

After undertaking our own review of the Ballachloan roundabout, and taking into account proposed alterations at Stoneymollan by Transport Scotland, we have developed a high level proposal for the mitigation we would require at this location which would include widening of the A811 W approach to allow for a left slip lane.

The proposed mitigation is shown below.



A summary of the modelling results is shown below.

The above table shows that the junction will operate well within capacity in all scenarios. In the PM peak the queues on the A811 W have been reduced from 80.2 PCU to a 6.0 PCU. The RFC is also below the theoretical capacity at 0.738 RFC. These figures are based on the information provided by the developer and may be subject to change once full clarification is received.

The works will include breakout of existing kerblines and surfacing, removal and replacement of signage, reset of kerbs and surfacing, relocation of 1No lighting column and changes to the signalised crossing however detailed design should be undertaken to review the full extent of works required.

Should the applicant be prepared to undertake any appropriate mitigation measures then WDC Roads services would then be in a position to support the application.

In regards to the above planning application I would offer the following response from WDC Roads.

WDC Roads have had the modelling/traffic figures assessed by our consultant (report attached) and as you can see there is still a number of point outstanding which would allow us to validate the report submitted in support of the application.

For your convenience and ease of reference I have listed these points below;

Consultant to confirm the correct land uses have been used.

Consultant to provide the August 2023 traffic scenario

A comparison of observed/ modelled queues should be provided along with justification / commentary as to the appropriateness of the base model results.

Further information needs to be provided on modelling validation and justification provided that existing junction models reasonably reflect existing conditions/ operation.

Whilst WDC still seek clarification from the applicants on the information highlighted in the report, however based on the information provided the proposed development will result in an increase in traffic flows in the AM, PM and Saturday peak and that the impact will result in a deterioration of the junction performance of the Stoneymollan Roundabout and Ballochloan (Old Luss Road) Roundabout.

Given the current figures result in a deterioration of junction performance at the Ballochloan (Old Luss Road) Roundabout, WDC Roads would require mitigation measures at this location to offset the increased traffic flow. We are aware that upgrade works have already been agreed with Transport Scotland in relation to the Stoneymollan Roundabout and therefore have not included for any additional measures at this location.

After undertaking our own review of the Ballachloan roundabout, and taking into account proposed alterations at Stoneymollan by Transport Scotland, we have developed a high level proposal for the mitigation we would require at this location which would include widening of the A811 W approach to allow for a left slip lane.

The proposed mitigation is shown below.



A summary of the modelling results is shown below.

The above table shows that the junction will operate well within capacity in all scenarios. In the PM peak the queues on the A811 W have been reduced from 80.2 PCU to a 6.0 PCU. The RFC is also below the theoretical capacity at 0.738 RFC. These figures are based on the information provided by the developer and may be subject to change once full clarification is received.

The works will include breakout of existing kerblines and surfacing, removal and replacement of signage, reset of kerbs and surfacing, relocation of 1No lighting column and changes to the signalised crossing however detailed design should be undertaken to review the full extent of works required.

Should the applicant be prepared to undertake any appropriate mitigation measures then WDC Roads services would then be in a position to support the application.

Following the respective email communications below last year including detailed timeline of submissions, updates and communication it was agreed by the project team to contact all the respective parties involved in one email. Since the emails we have sought to engage with individual parties seeking updates and to resolve the outstanding issues and press for the application to be determined as soon as legislatively possible.

This engagement has had limited success, and the client has requested we seek formal updates from all parties and report back by CoB on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March.

We are seeking updates on the following please:

 Meeting held between LLTNPA and SEPA February 2024 including responsibility and timescales for responses plus any follow up discussions.

Our understanding is that LLTNPA are awaiting feedback from SEPA regarding the proposed flood risk mitigation including compensatory storage before LLTNPA will confirm their position on previously developed land. SEPA have advised that discussions are ongoing but there is no timescale to respond just yet..

Meeting between LLTNPA and WDC 21 February 2024 to discuss the application.

Are you able to advise that the meeting took place, who attended and any potential feedback from it?

- Meeting held this week between LLTNPA Planners and/or any upcoming meetings with SEPA and WDC.
- With the exception of SEPA, you will all have been copied in on the Transport Technical Note submitted last week and hopefully an updated response by WDC Roads can be issued to LLTNPA quickly.



Following discussion and agreement within the project team, we thought it would be helpful for all decision-making parties involved in the In Principle planning application for Lomond Banks to provide a timeline of documents submitted and feedback received in relation to traffic and transport issues. This is to ensure that those who are not involved in the project on a daily basis have the full timeline within one email and help aid further discussion and progression of the application to determination. There are a number of key decisions that need to be made by a number of bodies to allow the application to move towards determination. These key decisions are highlighted at the conclusion of this email.

The timeline in relation to numerous traffic and transport matters is as follows:

**7 June 2022** – WDC Roads Consultation Response

WDC Roads issued a consultation response to LLTNPA in which 'No objection' to the application was confirmed. It was also confirmed that the scale and scope of the application was very similar to the previous application and as agreed with WDC Roads, the original Transport Assessment (TA) was used to model anticipated trip generation for the new application because as the current application was developed during the Pandemic which had lower background traffic levels. In order to provide robustness, an additional survey was undertaken in 2022 to gauge existing traffic levels. As this was also lower than the original survey, this evidence backed up the assessment and rationale for using the data from the original TA.

17 August 2022 & 16 September 2022 – Parking comments by Lomond Shores and Ross Greer MSP Following comments received from the owners of Lomond Shores and Ross Greer MSP regarding parking numbers a Parking and Signage Strategy (attached) was submitted to LLTNPA.

**17 November 2022 –** LLTNPA request for further information

This is to ensure that those who are not involved in the project on a daily basis have the full timeline within one email and help aid further discussion and progression of the application to determination. There are a number of key decisions that need to be made by a number of bodies to allow the application to move towards determination. These key decisions are highlighted at the conclusion of this email.

The timeline in relation to flood risk and mitigation is as follows:

#### Flood Risk Assessment

#### 20 June 2023

Stantec provided an updated Flood Risk Assessment (FRA) in response to SEPA's updated consultation response on 30 March 2023 to proposed changes made to the indicative layout and some reduced accommodation numbers. Both of these documents are on the LLTNPA Planning Portal but are attached for ease of reference. SEPA reviewed the updated FRA and noted that the West Riverside development area now had the potential to flood in extreme events under updated modelled climate change allowances (20% to 49%).

#### 28 July 2023

SEPA advised LLTNPA in their consultation response of 28<sup>th</sup> July 2023 (also on the planning portal and attached) that informal flood mitigation measures, such as proposed land and kerb raising, cannot be taken into account and would require the West Riverside area to be modified so that no development occurs in the identified flood risk areas. SEPA, however, did also advise LLTNPA that it would be prepared to review its position concerning the acceptability of flood risk mitigation measures and associated information requirements, if LLTNPA confirmed that, the development proposals at West Riverside met the "exceptions" criterion set out in sub paragraph iv of NPF4 Policy 22 a) – Flood Risk and Water Management

traffic and transport related requests were made:

- Clarification of the proposed car parking quantum; in particular, whether the stated quantum (ref. Tables 6.1 and 6.2 of the Transport Chapter of the EIA Report) has taken account of the pool/waterpark in addition to the separate quantum required for the 60-bed hotel (assuming this facility will be open to and visited by the wider public and not just hotel guests).
- Clarification that the 'Pierhead woodland parking' area will be sufficient to accommodate the proposed additional boat/trailer parking for Lomond Banks guests in addition to the hotel/waterpark. Information to indicate that the brown shaded areas on the parameters plan are sufficient to accommodate the quantum of parking required without encroachment into areas reserved for woodland.
- Please highlight the anticipated postdevelopment uplift in vehicle numbers in absolute/number of vehicles terms: a. For vehicles entering and leaving Balloch as a whole; b. At Ben Lomond Way (noted as a 33% increase); c. Old Luss Road (North) (noted as 84% increase) and d. Pier Road (noted as a 29% increase).
- Please provide a clear, layperson's explanation of when and for how long the uplift will be experienced (I.e., weekday/weekend, peak hour maximum or averaged across the day etc.) and how it will be experienced (I.e., will there be any increased delay or queueing?). It is important for the timing and duration of the main traffic impacts to be explained in relatable terms that can be understood by the public and this should be incorporated within the EIA NTS.
- Under Reg EIA Regs 26(4) noting the strong pattern of seasonal traffic variance within Balloch we request that you verify that the timing (year and month) of the traffic assessment survey work is an appropriate basis for assessment. Please provide further

For clarification N**PF4 Policy 22 a) iv** advises that "development proposals at risk of flooding or in a flood risk area **will only be supported**" if they are for the following:

"Redevelopment of previously used sites in built up areas where the LDP has identified a need to bring these into positive use and where proposals demonstrate that long term safety and resilience can be secured in accordance with relevant SEPA advice."

Additionally, for development proposals meeting the above criteria part iv), advises that where flood risk is managed at the site rather than avoided.

## <u>Previously Developed Land</u>

#### 19 September 2023

The attached Information Note was submitted to LLTNPA on 19 September 2023 and provides our evidence that the West Riverside area of the proposed Lomond Banks site **is previously developed land** mainly from recent railway activity.

The note also confirmed that the site is located within the development boundary of Balloch in a built-up area and is surrounded on 3 sides by housing, a rail station, retail, and leisure uses. This evidence in combination with the site being allocated in the previous local plan and current LDP means that the proposed holiday lodge uses at West Riverside have in our opinion fully meet the exceptions criteria iv of NPF4 Policy 22a. Therefore, it is our opinion that the site is capable of being developed and brought back into positive use and in accordance with relevant SEPA standards and requirements.

The Information Note was provided as evidence to which LLTNPA should be in a position to confirm to SEPA on the status of land at West Riverside and thereby allow SEPA the opportunity to review its position regarding development in the flood risk area and confirm whether the informal mitigation measures of land and kerb raising, would be permitted to be taken into account within the detailed design of the Lomond Banks proposals should it be approved.

#### October 2023

LLTNPA have not formally confirmed their position in relation to SEPAs question on NPF4 Policy 22a exceptions and the status of West Riverside as previously developed land. Following a conversation between LLTNPA with Stantec in early October, it was agreed that the LLTNPA would ask SEPA the question of:

Should it be determined the proposal meets the

or additional evidence in support of your response. We are also seeking the further assistance of West Dunbartonshire Roads Authority in relation to this point.

The response to this Information Request was submitted to LLTNPA on 13 February 2023 and is detailed below and is also attached.

Also, in **November 2022** and following a meeting between WDC Roads and LLTNPA it was requested that a traffic assessment to reflect peak summer traffic. A summer traffic assessment was undertaken in August 2023 and is covered below.

# **6 December 2022 -** Unilateral Voluntary Undertaking

On behalf of the applicant a Unilateral Voluntary Undertaking (UVU) known as the "Lomond Promise" was submitted to LLTNPA and is attached. It is available on the Lomond Banks website <a href="https://www.lomondbanks.com">www.lomondbanks.com</a> but is not on the LLTNPA planning portal. The Lomond Promise is a legal document that binds the applicant to vows made to the community at pre-application stage, and included providing sustainable transport measures such as:

- Green Travel Plan.
- Summer Traffic Survey to be carried out once operational.
- Provision of an electric hopper bus to serve the development.
- Investigate integrated bus/rail tickets options.
- Cyclescheme initiative for employees.
- Provision of electric buggies for customers within the site.
- Provision of signage and facilities for walkers and cyclists.

It came in response to issues raised by the community throughout the planning application process and it is aimed to reassure the local community that the applicant is committed to having a positive long-term impact on the area by being an active and responsible participant of the Balloch community.

#### **17 November 2023**

SEPA responded to the above question and advised in the attached email:

Should it be determined the proposal meets the requirements of Policy 22a part iv) then additional information would be required from the applicant: The proposed individual (indicative) chalets will need to be raised above the flood risk level with safe egress and prevent an island of development. SEPA advised that significant redesign to tie the proposed chalets to higher ground and that the inclusion of a raised walkway, for example, would not stop it being considered an island of development. For clarification, a raised walkway has not been proposed by the applicant but rather a raised footpath linking to each chalet and providing access and egress on at least one elevation. SEPA also advised that land raising to permanently elevate a site above the flood level could be acceptable but would have to be linked with appropriate compensatory storage to ensure there is no reduction in floodplain capacity and increased risk for others. SEPA therefore requested that the applicant needs to demonstrate this level of mitigation would be effective.

SEPA confirmed that informal measure such as raised kerbs and land will not be considered acceptable.

## Flood Risk and Mitigation

#### 8 December 2023

Following SEPAs latest feedback of 17 November, please find attached the applicant's Information Note to demonstrate that proposed development at West Riverside can be delivered fully in line with NPF4 Policy 22 and SEPAs requirements.

A flood extents and mitigation plan of West Riverside (attached and within Information Note) has been prepared and identifies a number of areas where compensatory storage could be located. These locations have been identified to ensure there is no tree loss.

Because the application is In Principle and the proposed holiday lodge locations are indicative, the exact extents and locations of the compensatory storage would need to be determined at the detailed design stage once the number and layout of the holiday lodges is fixed, and a total volume of displaced flood water is established. At present the drawing indicates that there are sufficient locations to be able to provide the equivalent flood volume close to where it is lost.

which routes through the clearing and chalets, the proposal is that it will be constructed from earthworks and raised to at least the 1 in 200yr+CC level of 10.65mAOD. It will not be elevated above the floodplain on stilts, or a structure as was may have been thought by SEPA, and it will provide permanent access/egress route from the proposed chalets. Within the attached Information Note it has been demonstrated how the proposal complies with NPF4 Policy 22 and how the criteria stipulated within Policy 22 will be met. #### Conclusion

As you may appreciate there has been a considerable amount of work prepared and submitted to the LLTNPA and reviewed by SEPA with detailed feedback over the past 9 months. The latest Information Note should be the final required submission and we are not aware of any other outstanding issues. As said at the start of this email, there are a number of key decisions that need to be made to allow the application to progress to determination in early 2024. They are as follows:

 LLTNPA to publish the latest Information Note on the Planning Portal and several other

Members of the project team met with Jackie Baillie MSP to update her on progress of the planning application.

Jackie listened to all of the points but when it came to traffic she interiected. She summarised her position as being that the people of Balloch remained concerned about increased traffic and that the headline statistic that increases on a peak day amounting to only one to two extra cars per minute would not be taken seriously. It was reiterated that from a technical roads perspective there isn't a problem with the infrastructure and Lomond Banks impact on it. Whilst Jackie acknowledged that any existing transport problems isn't for Lomond Banks to solve, but the perception locally is that it will become worse, and that Lomond Banks need to be doing more than offering green transport initiatives in the Lomond Promise. Jackie suggested the Stoneymollan roundabout northbound required improvement and his should be considered by Lomond Banks to help with. Whilst Transport Scotland nor WDC Roads have raised any required roads solution it was acknowledged that the applicant would engage directly with Transport Scotland to discuss possible options. Following the 3 March meeting with Jackie Baillie the project team engaged directly with Transport Scotland to discuss Stoneymollan Roundabout. Over the following months it was agreed by Transport Scotland and Lomond Banks would finance the provision of traffic signals and revised kerb lines. These would be delivered by Transport Scotland. A signed Letter of Undertaking was submitted to Transport Scotland on 12 June 2023 for their review and agreement. A signed Letter of Undertaking (attached) was subsequently issued by Transport Scotland on 10 October 2023.

West Dunbartonshire Council Roads would look for a Framework Travel Plan to be submitted at this stage for review.

An understanding of how the car parking will operate will have a knock-on effect into how the surrounding junctions will operate. If daily departure profiles cannot be provided to allow an understanding of the parking levels and traffic movements throughout the day, a recommendation of further transport assessment requirements should be as a condition of consent.

The requirement for operation and management of buggy buses to transport guests around the site and negate the need for cars once quest have arrived should be a condition of planning consent.

Traffic Management Plan should be a condition of planning consent and should include detail on locations of car parking, locations of "Wardens" and to where and for what reason traffic will be diverted to other car parks and by which route vehicles will take.

Any requirement for a full Travel Plan and Traffic
Management Plan to be submitted at this stage of the
application as a requirement of the EIA would be a
Planning consideration rather than a Roads
consideration. WDC Roads would be happy to review any
information that is provided should these full

#### 25 September 2023 - Summer Traffic Assessment

The attached Summer Traffic Assessment of August 2023 was submitted to LLTNPA and WDC Roads were copied in the email submission. The scope of this assessment was agreed by both Transport Scotland and WDC Roads. In comparison to the 2017 surveys, the 2023 traffic surveys show a lower level of traffic recorded passing through the two junctions in both the weekday morning peak hour and Saturday peak hour. The recorded 2023 traffic flows recorded in the weekday evening peak hour are higher than the 2017 surveys for both junctions. Overall, the assessment showed very little difference with the 2017 traffic surveys and that both the Stoneymollan Roundabout and the McDonalds Roundabout will continue to operate with adequate reserve capacity with no significant material traffic impact on their operation. The results show that the existing roundabout junctions operate within capacity and will continue to operate within capacity with the addition of proposed development traffic in 2031 (opening year).

# **10 October 2023 –** Stoneymollan Roundabout & Transport Scotland

A signed Letter of Undertaking (attached) was issued by Transport Scotland and provides commitment from Lomond Banks to finance agreed improvements to A82/Stoneymollan Roundabout. It would also be helpful to discuss what you know about the agreement with Transport Scotland and the works we understand are proposed to be undertaken to the Stoneymollen Roundabout.

Morning

Here's a note to update you on relevant aspects on Lomond Banks to inform your own process and timescales for the Council's response, further to our recent call. I hope the note below helps update you.

# **Transport**

We received a Summer Traffic Survey from the applicant on 25<sup>th</sup> September, and prior to

that a Traffic and Transport Note, that were both cc'd to the Road Authority. The case officer has requested a meeting with WDC Road Authority to understand whether this alters their position (currently no objection) and whether any further information is likely to be requested from the applicant. Let me know if you would like to join the meeting. We have not yet formally/publicly consulted the Road Authority or Transport Scotland on this new information but plan to in due course.

Additionally, we understand that the applicant has agreed a memorandum of understanding with Transport Scotland in relation to works to Stoneymollen Roundabout and that this is currently with Transport Scotland for sign off. We have been promised a copy by the applicant's agent and are still awaiting this.

We understand from the applicant that these works are not required as 'mitigation' but are being volunteered up by the applicant in the event the application is approved. We will need to understand what these works entail and have confirmation (either from Transport Scotland or WDC) whether there is any requirement for the works as a result of the recent summer survey (or whether it remains that these works are not required as mitigation).

#### Flood Risk

You'll be aware that SEPA responded to the Feb 2023 consultation requiring a revised flood risk assessment which was received in July. Having considered SEPA's response and the applicant's position there are some aspects we are seeking clarification on.

#### Other

The applicant is currently undertaking ecological survey update work which is underway with reports to be submitted in the coming weeks.

We currently expect to publish and undertake one final round of public consultation on all the submissions – considering the requirements within EIA regs - once we have received all the information which is awaited and are content that there is no further information to be requested/submitted as a result of the outstanding flood and transport matters. Will let you know when this is confirmed and out timescales.

It has come to my attention that your team was not consulted when we received an updated flood risk assessment from the applicant in late June 2023. Please accept my apologies for this oversight.

The updated flood risk assessment was requested by SEPA when we consulted on the revised proposals on 23 February 2023 (post NPF4 publication). I note we did not receive a response from your department at that time - and so we understand your current position remains one of 'no objection' (as per your email of 23 June 2022).

For your awareness SEPA was consulted on the updated FRA in June this year and has maintained their objection to the application on the grounds that the site floods. However their response indicates that they would review their position if the site meets the exceptions criteria for previously developed land within Policy 22a of NPF4.

In response the applicant submitted the attached statement (a copy of which has been provided to SEPA).

We are in the process of seeking clarity on SEPA's position in the event we consider the site does benefit from the NPF4 exception for previously developed land (as the applicant contends in this note) and are awaiting their response. This may lead to further flood-related submissions from the applicant and we will consult you in that event.

I wanted to draw this situation to your attention, in case you were not aware, and offer the opportunity for your team to provide any further comment at this point, should you wish to do so.

- Confirmation of the Summer daily network peak hours and detail if these are different from the neutral month assessed.
- Transport Scotland Data highlights that Summer traffic is higher than neutral month.
   Assessment/comparison of Summer traffic volumes should be undertaken to allow an understanding of typical traffic conditions and any impacts on the road network considered within the TA. This should also include a comparison of current traffic volumes with the 2017 survey data.
- Consideration of the actual peak hours of the development should be provided alongside the
  review of summer peak traffic hours as outlined above to allow the impact of the development
  on the surrounding road network to be fully considered.

#### Parking and Signage Strategy

- More detail should be provided into how Travel Plan initiatives will be managed i.e Travel Plan Co-ordinator
- Daily arrival departure profile should be provided along with a parking accumulation to allow understanding of parking levels and traffic movements throughout the day
- Confirmation that other businesses have agreed to alter opening times to operate as overspill
  car parking
- · Confirmation on who will operate and manage the buggy buses
- Appendix A provides details for Traffic Wardens (It is assumed these are Parking Attendants
  or Traffic Marshalls who will operate within the site). The information should be further
  expanded to a Traffic Management Plan, detailing locations of car parking, locations of

"Wardens" and to where and for what reason traffic will be diverted to other carparks and by which route vehicles will have to take.
