## **REQUEST FOR ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION**

Thank you for your request for access to information held by the National Park Authority, which was received by email on 7 April 2026. We have processed your request under the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 and have provided our response below.

### **Your Request**

*I request:*

*Recorded deer densities within the Park, for each of the past 3 years.*

### **Our Response**

Although the National Park Authority does not calculate deer densities on any land within the National Park, we do hold some information that is relevant to your request. This information can be found in the *Summary Table of Deer Management Groups in LLTNP* on pages 15-21 of our Herbivore Delivery Plan.

The data published in the Herbivore Delivery Plan includes

- The most recent mean deer densities for each Deer Management Group
- The range of deer densities per land holding
- The count method and date
