REQUEST FOR ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION

Thank you for your email of 10 February 2026, in which you requested access to information held by the National Park Authority. As the information you have requested relates to energy consumption, we consider that your request is for environmental information. We have, therefore, applied the exemption detailed in section 39(2) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 and processed your requested under the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (the EIRs).

Your Request

Please could you provide the following information relating to your organisation's energy usage:

- 1. Copies of electricity and gas bills (or a summary equivalent) for the most recent 12-month period available.*
- 2. Total annual electricity consumption (kWh) for the same period.*
- 3. Total annual gas consumption (kWh) for the same period.*
- 4. Total annual cost (£) for electricity and gas, separately if available.*
- 5. The name of your current energy supplier(s).*
- 6. The contract end date(s) for electricity and gas supply.*

As agreed via telephone, we have provided the requested information in relation to the National Park Authority's headquarters, at Carrochan, in Balloch. (As discussed during our
