REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

Thank you for your request for access to information held by the National Park Authority, which was received by email on 05 May 2026. The information you have requested is environmental information, as defined in Regulation 2 of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (EIRs). We have therefore applied the exemption in section 39(2) of FOISA and dealt with your request under the EIRs alone.

- 2) *Any information the LLTNPA holds about whether an Island Warden is in post as required by the S75 agreement*
- 3) *Any information the LLTNPA holds on the membership of the Formal Working Group and any records the LLTNPA holds of the meetings due to be held in March and September.*

1. A copy of the annual report you have requested.
2. A copy of an email confirming the appointment of an Island Warden.
3. Copies of agendas for the meetings of the Inchconnachan Island Management Plan group on 29 May 2025, 10 November 2025 (which took place 13 November 2025) and 21 April 2026.
